

## Parent Curriculum Overview EY1, Term 2 2019-20

EY1 Term 2	
Music - EY 1	Unit Title: Storytelling through Music: Billy's Band/ Peter and The Wolf Unit Description: In Music, children will be listening to the musical story of Billy's Band and Prokofiev's Peter and the Wolf and will learn how the different instruments of the orchestra portray the characters. Children will then go onto explore storytelling through music, creating their own compositions of favourite stories. Children will also work towards recognising and understanding the Musical Elements of Pulse and Rhythm.
Mandarin - EY1	2.1 Unit Title: Chinese New Year Celebration Students will be learning to greet during Chinese New Year and understanding the term 'Happy New Year' through singing a traditional Children's Chinese New Year song. We will also learn to read and write a few zodiac animals through a traditional Chinese New Year story.
	<u>2.2 Unit Title: The Cat And The Moon</u> Students will be learning a new story of The Cat and The Moon in Mandarin through our gesture-based AIM programme. Students will be learning to perform a role from the play with some support. In the story, students will be understanding some common verbs, adjectives, simple place prepositions and sentence structures.
PE - EY1	<u>Unit Title: Gymnastics</u> Students will be learning to jump, balance, travel and roll in a variety of ways and to perform shapes and movement patterns. Apparatus will be used for exploration of movement themes.
	<u>Unit Title: Ball games</u> Students will learn ball skills individually and learn to apply them in

	pairs and small groups. Cooperation with others will be a key social
	skill developed in this unit.
Learning Technologies - EY1	<u>Unit Title: Our Digital World</u> In this unit, children will develop a range of information communication technology skills. They will compare the real world with the digital world and will consider ways that they can keep themselves safe when visiting the digital world. They will become familiar with the concept of manipulation and will explore tools that can be used to manipulate images and videos.
English	Reading Children will continue on with their RWI program and guided reading lessons with their class teacher. <u>Writing</u> Children will be learning to write information texts, poetry, stories and descriptions.
