- ★ You will come up with and present solutions to change and uplift the lives of real people in a remote community in Nepal.

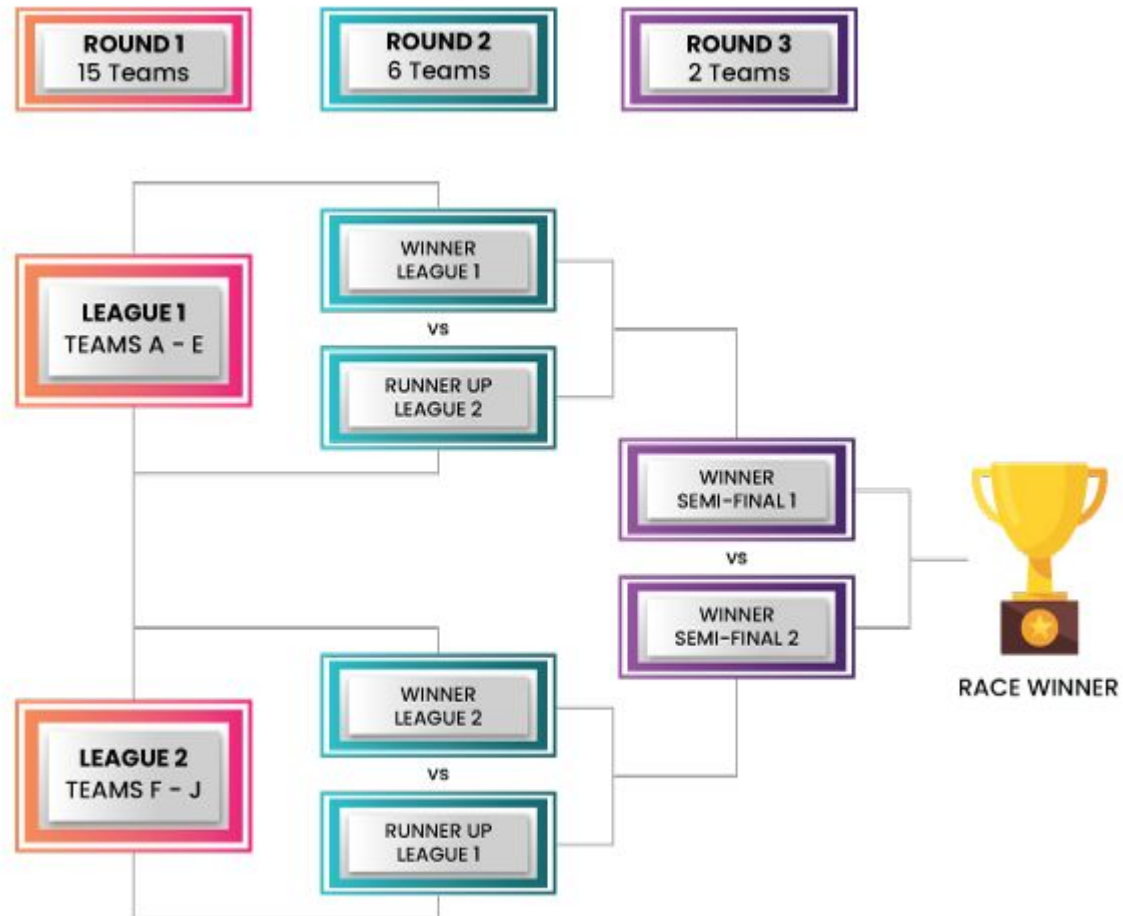

### THE RACE4GOOD INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL LEAGUE:

Designed to enable every school year student to get involved in the race; providing numerous opportunities to contribute their skills, passion, and expertise. Successful teams will draw on the wide range of talents and interests found within the school and will channel these into tackling a diverse range of challenges throughout the race experience.

### BUSINESS MENTORS:

Each Race Hub will be allocated a Business Mentor. Meeting virtually, business mentors will share their entrepreneurial skills, expertise and industry knowledge and support Race hub volunteers and activities. Business Mentors will be selected from a wide-range of departments and functions to ensure maximum impact for all students.



# *How will the event take place?*

- ★ *The whole event will take place online through a combination of platforms like Zoom or Google Meet, and also through an online collaboration area called Basecamp.*



- ★ *You can participate from anywhere, so you will not necessarily need to be at school when the event is taking place, i.e., when you are working from home during online learning.*



# Commitment

1. You must commit for the entire duration of the event:

*Monday 1st March - Friday 2nd April\**

*\*Note: the final round of the event will take place during the 1st week of the Easter holidays - however, only 2 teams will be in the competition at this stage.*

2. *Time commitment guide:*

<i>Stage of Race</i>	<i>Duration</i>	<i>Combined time</i>
<i>Round 1: Uplift a Family</i>	<i>21 days (1st-22nd March)</i>	<i>5 hours per week</i>
<i>Round 2: Uplift several families</i>	<i>7 Days (23rd-29th March)</i>	<i>8 hours</i>
<i>Round 3: Community Uplift</i>	<i>2 days (30th March-2nd April)</i>	<i>5 Hours</i>
