

## **Primary Snacks and Lunches**



- Please ensure your child has a named water bottle
- Children will need a healthy snack for the first break time (please note, sweets and lollies are not permitted in school)
- We encourage children to bring healthy balanced lunches and use as little single use plastic as possible
- We are a nut-free school, so please ensure snacks and lunches are nut-free. A gentle reminder that items such a store bought pesto, some wafers and nutella, contain nuts. We have a child in Year 1 with a severe nut allergy.







## **Birthdays and Cultural Celebrations**



- We love to celebrate each child's special day at our school. When it's your child's birthday, the
  class will celebrate them with their own special traditions, such as singing birthday songs or
  letting them wear the class birthday crown or sash. To ensure all children can fully participate, we
  ask that you refrain from sending in any food items or party bags due to potential allergies and
  dietary restrictions. Our focus is on making every birthday celebration inclusive and enjoyable
  for the whole class.
- We would love to invite you in to share any cultural festivals or special days that you celebrate with your family. If you feel comfortable sharing, please let me know!







## **Primary Library Arrangements**



- The DBIS Library provides a collection of books and online resources to support the curriculum and, importantly, reading for pleasure.
- Y1 6 classes are timetabled to visit the library once a week.
- Students are required to have **one** labelled A3 zippered waterproof plastic pouch to protect resources from damage.
- We appreciate your support of your child's borrowing by ensuring library book/s and folders come to school on the day that the Library is timetabled. The lending period is 1 week and children have begun borrowing 1 book which can increase later on in the term.
- Parents are welcome to visit the library before and after school with their child. Please check parent opening times on the library website: <u>library.dbis.edu.hk</u>

## **Year 1 Home Learning Information**



- There are some aspects of the curriculum that children need additional time to rehearse and practice in order for learning to be embedded.
- Homework in Year 1 will focus on developing a love of reading; therefore, the children will bring home reading books on a regular basis that are pitched at a level at which they are demonstrating confidence so they can share and celebrate their reading skills. We also encourage you as parents to read often to your child to ensure they are exposed to a wide repertoire of vocabulary and literature as this will support their overall development in reading and writing.
- We encourage you to read with your child in your home language if this is different to English as this supports
  children in reading for pleasure and listening to stories in a language in which they are confident. Your child will
  have a home-school link book where you can record the reading completed at home. Children are expected to read
  a minimum of three times a week and record this in their Home-School Link Book.
- In addition, the children will be encouraged to practise spelling high-frequency words, common exception words and Year 1 and Year 2 spelling patterns. Once your child has settled into Year 1, these will come home on a regular basis in a quantity suited to your child. The words may be repeated throughout the year in order to ensure learning is embedded. Activities that will help engage your children with spelling will be suggested.

## **School Uniform**

# DISCOVERY BAY

DBIS has a compulsory school uniform. Information regarding uniform can be found on the school's website. Some key points to remember:

- School shoes: all children must wear plain black school shoes, smart trainers (free from any additional markings or colours) or navy sandals
- All students must have a hat for outdoor PE and playtime. We have a 'no hat, no play' policy
- Jewellery: watches and small stud earrings are permitted (but must be covered or removed for PE), no other jewellery is permitted to be worn to school
- Make-up, nail varnish and temporary tattoos are not permitted to be worn to school. Hair dye is only permitted if of a natural colour
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back
- During colder months please ensure you purchase a school uniform jumper for your child to wear
- Children can wear their PE kit all day on PE days





## Supervision outside of school hours



- Students should be accompanied to and from school by an adult wherever possible. If you need your child to walk home unaccompanied from Year 3 onwards, we please ask that you sign the permission register linked <a href="HERE">HERE</a> (or scan the QR code below).
- For Y1 and Y2, you will have provided key people for collection during the PTCs. Photo ID is requested at pick up for at least the first few weeks until we are familiar with the trusted adults. Please notify us in advance if there is someone different picking up your child.
- Y1 children will be walked to their ECAs by an adult after school, but must be collected by an adult at the end of the ECA.
- All families to have vacated the campus by 3:20 pm unless they have an ECA.
- Please note, medical provision runs from 8:00 am 3:30 pm.
   When ECAs begin, the nurses will be on hand between 7:30 am 4:30 pm.






