



**Join together with your friends and family on the**  
**DBIS Walking School Bus**  
**on Friday 31st October 2025**

As is our tradition, DBIS is celebrating Sustainability Day 2025 with our Walking School Bus, on the morning of Friday 31st October. The goal is to have the whole DBIS community walking to school together and for there to be no golf buggies or hire cars in the school parking lot. To ensure that all children can enjoy this experience, there will be **no Friday morning ECAs on this day.**

We would like to invite **students to come to school wearing old or reused clothing** on that day and to bring a suggested donation of HK\$20 for **ReDress Hong Kong/House Charities.**

We will be starting from many different locations around DB – you can either begin at one of the starting locations below or join in along the way. If the entire distance is too far for the younger students, please consider taking a bus to the Plaza or any of the starting locations and joining in there.

If you do not live on one of the main routes or there is no starting location near you, please join the main route at the point closest to your location. Residents of Bijou Hamlet can join at the bottom of Golf Course Road or at the Plaza.

DBIS staff will be present at the various starting locations to lead the way. We will also help the parade cross the main road at a few key points (Marina Drive, La Serene Road, Golf Club Road, steps down from Middle Lane and at Greenery).

Children at the **EYFS Campus** can choose to walk with their friends and siblings from any of the starting locations/times listed below and then meet **Mrs Brislen-Patel and Mrs Foster outside Discovery Bay Recreation Club (DBRC) in the South Plaza at 8.40 am.** From there, the children will all walk together to our EYFS campus.

**Please note** that routes to the Main Campus that go past the EYFS Campus will not stop at the EYFS Campus; after dropping Primary/Secondary children off at the Main Campus,

younger siblings can either make their own way back with their accompanying adult to the EYFS Campus or meet Mrs Brislen-Patel and Mrs Foster outside DBRC at 8.40 am.

All EYFS and Primary School children must be accompanied by an adult, and EYFS children must be accompanied throughout the route until they have reached their classroom.

**Please also note** that the South Lantau and Tung Chung school buses will operate as normal, and children will be dropped off at their respective campuses at the usual time.

### **Starting Locations & Times**

**This is the main road route from Coastline:**

1. **Coastline** – 7.45 am (in front of #32, at the roundabout) – picking up **Cherish, Blossom, Costa, Onda, La Costa** and **Beach Village** along the way.

**The following routes will join up with this main route:**

2. **Crestmont Villa** – 7.48 am (in front of #59) – picking up **Caperidge** and **Twilight** along the way and joining up with the main route at the corner of Twilight.

## **This is the main road route from the Siena/Chianti end of DB:**

**Chianti, Peaceful, Graceful, Joyful, Celestial** – 8.05 am (at the bottom of the Chianti escalator) – walking through the **Siena Two low-rises** (1–17, 32–46) to the main road and picking up **Mountain View, Sunrise, Seaview** and **Starview** along the way.
